Anne Ryder is a national award winning anchor and TV reporter, columnist, and speaker. Indianapolis born and raised, she worked at the NBC affiliate for 20 years, becoming the longest-tenured anchor in the station's history.

Her reporting has taken her all over the world, from war-time Bosnia and Kosovo, to Northern Ireland, to Calcutta, India. Anne was the only American reporter in more than a decade to be granted a sit-down interview with Mother Teresa. It was the final interview the nun gave before her death.

Anne created and produces *Hope to Tell*, and *In an Instant*,™ through which she tells stories that move and inspire others.

She is President of Ryder Media LLC, and maintains an affiliation with WTHR, Channel 13 to provide special reports. Anne is also a columnist for two magazines, and is a familiar voice on the radio through her affiliation with Susquehanna Broadcasting.

Anne is also a wife and mother who can speak to the issues of striving for balance in the workplace. In 2004, she stepped away from nightly anchoring at the peak of her popularity in order to spend not just *quality*, but *quantity* time with her young daughter.

Anne has earned numerous national, regional and state honors for her reporting, including two **National Edward R. Murrow Awards** in a single year. She also won the prestigious national **Gabriel** and **Wilbur** awards for her television reporting and 12 regional **Emmy** awards. Anne's magazine feature writing garnered a first place award by The Society of Professional Journalists.

A graduate of the University of Missouri-Columbia Journalism School, Anne is the recipient of honorary doctorates of Humane Letters from three Universities. She serves on several boards and is an active community volunteer. In 2004, the Indiana Governor presented Anne with the highest citizen award the state of Indiana bestows.
